



Henkel Romania is moving to a new office building in

September 2025

Bucharest, March 28, 2025 - Henkel Romania announces that in September 2025 will move its Bucharest headquarters to the new *Equilibrium 2* office building, located in Floreasca area. Thus, for the first time, all Henkel employees from Bucharest, from all business units (Adhesive Technologies și Henkel Consumer Brands) and functions will work together, in the same head office. The actual relocation of the employees from the two current locations in Bucharest – Ionița Vornicul 1-7 and Daniel Danilopolu 4-6 – will take place at the beginning of September 2025.

The new Henkel Romania's headquarters, located *in the new Equilibrium 2 building* (certified LEED, WiredScore Platinum and Access4You Silver) will have all the facilities of a modern working environment („Smart Work @ Henkel”), with café and social spaces, meeting and projection rooms, collaboration space, quiet area, informal spaces, as well as many other facilities outside the building.

The "Smart Work @ Henkel" concept offers an open, ergonomic workspace and a high degree of flexibility for employees, natural light and many design elements that create an eco-friendly space that reflects our company's interest for sustainability and social responsibility. The new headquarters is intended to be a place that encourages collaboration and creativity, stimulates innovation, induces well-being and a sense of belonging to Henkel's culture and values.
